Registration: Oct 24th – Nov. 18th ***This letter does not register your team, all teams must fill out an official registration form.**

Season Begins: Saturday January 7th

Game Day: Saturday mornings

* All coaches and co-coaches are required to pass a background check (no cost to the coach) before they will be allowed to coach. Information regarding background checks will be included in the coaches' packet.

Practice and Games: Practices and games will be held on Saturday mornings. The first week each team will practice for an hour with no game. The following week each team will practice for the first half hour and play a game for the second half hour. Practices and games will be monitored by each coach. Pee-Wee Hoops is an introduction for 4 year olds and 5 year olds not enrolled in Kindergarten to the game of basketball. A game schedule will be given out at the coaches meeting for the season.

Coaches Meeting: Wednesday, December 14th, at 7:00p.m. at the Republic Community Center.

Pee-Wee Hoops Basketball Rules
2017

1. Pee-Wee Hoops is an instructional league designed to introduce children to the game of basketball. Since this is an instructional league, coaches and parents are responsible for refereeing the games.
2. Each team will have the court for one hour. The first half hour each team will practice on opposite sides of the court. The second half hour the two teams will scrimmage.
3. The clock will be set for sixty minutes on the scoreboard. At the end of the first half hour each team will put five players on the court. Substitutions may be made during any dead ball. No official score will be kept. Personal fouls will not be recorded, so coaches please use your best judgment on when to sit players down when they are constantly fouling others.
4. Basketball Size: Junior Ball
4. Goal Height: 8 feet
5. Free throws: No free throws will be shot, if a player is fouled on a shot it is a dead ball out of bounds for the offensive team. No free throws will be shot due to the time associated in setting everyone up to take a free throw.
6. There will be no three second violation for standing in the lane.
7. No half-court or full-court pressing is allowed. Teams are restricted to playing defense behind the 3 point line until the ball enters the 3 point arc. Once a team has established possession in their back-court the ball can not be stolen until the player crosses their offensive 3 point arc.
8. Teams must register on official registration forms. Forms must be completed in their entirety before the first game of the season. Teams found playing with players not listed on their roster will forfeit that game. Teams found using a player who is on another team roster will forfeit that game and the player will be suspended for the next two games.
11. The Roster must be filled out and the Code of Ethics signed by the head coach and the assistant coach and turned in before the season begins.
12. No players will be allowed to transfer teams after the first game of the season has been played.
13. All teams must have a minimum of seven participating players on their roster and we recommend no more than twelve. If a team has less than 7 players on their roster we reserve the right to add additional players to the team.
14. Players must be 4 years old by January 7, 2017 to be eligible to participate. 5 year olds are allowed to participate preferably if they are not enrolled in kindergarten. Players may play on only **one team per age division** in the youth basketball program.
15. Players must have same color shirts. Numbers on the shirts are optional.
16. All team members present and dressed out must play at least eight (8) minutes of each game. The number of minutes played may be monitored. If a coach is found to be playing a player less than eight minutes the team will forfeit that game and the coach will be suspended for the next game.
17. Two adult coaches are permitted on the bench. Each team is allowed to have one coach on the court to help assist in the coordination of the game.
18. Each team will receive two coaches' passes good for free entry into any & all of the games during the season. Coaches' passes must be shown at the gate. All fans between the ages of 12 and 55 will be required to pay a \$1.00 entry fee per league game.
19. The recreation supervisor reserves the right to make final determination on any rules or interpretations that may arise throughout the season.

Republic Parks & Recreation Coaches Code of Ethics



As a Coach in the Republic Parks and Recreation Department Program:

- I will place the needs of the participants ahead of a personal desire to win.
- I will not engage in unsportsmanlike conduct with any coach, parent, player, participant, official or any other attendee nor encourage my team or any other person to do so.
- I will not engage in any behavior which would endanger the health, safety or wellbeing of any coach, parent, player, participant, official or any other attendee nor encourage my team or any other person to do so.
- I will not use drugs or alcohol while at a youth sports event and will not attend, coach, officiate or participate in a youth sports event while under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
- I will not engage in the use of profanity or encourage my team or any other person to do so.
- I will treat any coach, parent, player, participant, official or any other attendee with respect regardless of race, creed, color, national origin, sex, sexual orientation or ability. I will encourage my team to also do so.
- I will not engage in verbal or physical threats or abuse aimed at any coach, parent, player, participant, official or any other attendee nor encourage my team or any other person to do so.
- I will not initiate a fight or scuffle with any coach, parent, player, participant, official or any other attendee or encourage my team or any other person to do so.
- I will be knowledgeable in the rules of each sport that I coach and will teach and abide by the rules of the game.
- I will provide each player with the opportunities for equal playing time.
- I will remember that the game is for kids...not adults.

I understand that if I have any criminal charges brought against me that are listed in our Criteria for Exclusion in the Background Screening Policy for Volunteers during my term of service to the Republic Parks & Recreation Department, I will be required to immediately disclose the nature of the charges to the Athletic Superintendent or Parks & Recreation Director and voluntarily terminate my duties until a determination is made by the Athletic Superintendent or Parks & Recreation Director regarding the effect of the pending charges on my functions within the program.
