



# REPUBLIC POLICE DEPARTMENT QUICK FACTS

No new officers have been added since 2006.

Two (2) positions were eliminated in 2020 to address regional pay deficiencies.

Between December 2020 and February 2021, there were 65 shifts with only three (3) officers on duty and 22 shifts with only two (2) officers on duty. The preferred number of officers on duty is six (6) per shift.

Between January 1-March 4, 2021, the Republic Police Department was "blacked out" a total of 38 hours that has been accounted for and numerous other short-term instances of 20 minutes or less.

Detectives are currently working 50% higher caseloads than the preferred number.

Subsidized out of the Street Department budget in the amount of \$600,000 due to allowable language in the State Motor Fuel Tax & Motor Sales Tax.
